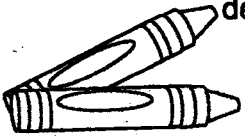
What The Students Will Be Learning

Social Studies- The students will be learning about how to be a good citizen.

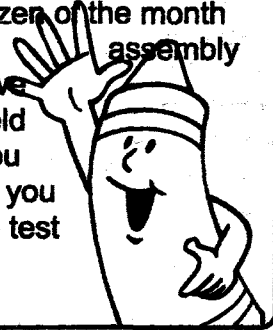
Science- The students will be learning about how to describe objects and make observations.

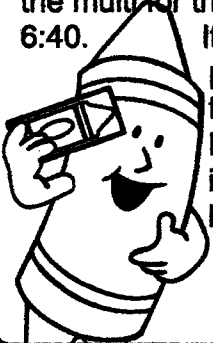
** Please note that we will be going on a field trip on the 18th. If you would like to join us, you **MUST** have your TB test on file in the office.
